The way that you navigate the library, we have a couple of options, but the first option here is on the side with the search filters. So you can have search filters for messages, which are based on the communication plan, the MnDOT communication plan, and you also have messenger and audience. These are basically the two and from of a letter, who is making the communication and who they directing it toward.

Last but not least, you have resource types; flyers and handouts are the most popular at the moment, but there are a whole series of other resource types that can be added to the site. Now if you don't want to search by search filters, that's fine. If you have a more specific term that you'd like to search for, you can just use the search bar, so you could search for something like "asset management", and the site will automatically filter out the resources that have "asset management" either in the title or in the resource description.
