You are invited to participate in the Transportation Performance Management (TPM) Pooled Fund Peer Exchange, which will be held at the MnDOT Central Office TEC Center, located at 395 John Ireland Boulevard, in St. Paul, Minnesota on November 14th and 15th, 2019. This opportunity is open to State DOT and MPO members of the TPM Pooled Fund. We will start at 12:00 PM on Thursday, November 14th and end at noon on Friday, November 15th.

The purpose of the peer exchange is to advance the state of TPM practice, including sharing lessons learned and discussing the ingredients for good TPM implementation.
